

Emailer (safe.emailer)

This FME package contains the FME Emailer transformer and the associated Google Gmail web service for FME. The Emailer transformer can be used to send one email per input feature via Simple Mail Transfer Protocol (SMTP). Both HTML and Plain Text emails may be sent, each with one or more attachments. This transformer is often used to notify recipients of translation status.

Usage

To use this transformer, a server that accepts SMTP requests must be available as well as the connection parameters and authentication fully specified.

Optionally, if you have a [Google Gmail](#) account, the Emailer transformer can use your Gmail account credentials (either via a previously defined FME web connection, or by setting up a new FME web connection right from the transformer) to send an email.

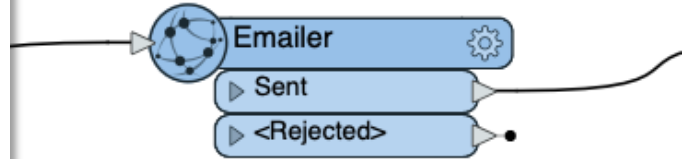
